 If found in closed terrain, you may be subject to legal prosecution AND the loss of skiing and riding privileges. Snowcats, snowmobiles, AND unmarked obstacles may be encountered at any time. NON-LIFT ACCESS TO SKI AREA FACILITIES SUCH AS UPHILL SNOWSHOEING, HIKING, OR "SKINNING" MAY PRESENT HIGH DANGER OR PERSONAL INJURY TO PARTICIPANTS AND THEREFORE MAY BE LIMITED OR FORBIDDEN BASED ON CONDITIONS ON MOUNTAIN ACTIVITY AND/OR MOUNTAIN POLICY.
