

BACK COUNTRY ADVISORY

THERE ARE ELEMENTS OF RISK THAT COMMON SENSE AND PERSONAL AWARENESS CAN HELP REDUCE. REGARDLESS OF HOW YOU DECIDE TO USE THE SLOPES, ALWAYS SHOW COURTESY TO OTHERS. PLEASE ADHERE TO THE CODE LISTED BELOW AND SHARE WITH OTHERS THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR A SAFE OUTDOOR EXPERIENCE

- Always stay in control. You must be able to stop, or avoid other people
- People ahead of you have the rightof-way. It's your responsibility to avoid
- Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield
- If you are involved in or witness a collision or accident, you must
- Always use proper devices to help

Observe and obey all posted signs

- Keep off closed trails and closed
- You must not use lifts or terrain if your ability is impaired through use of alcohol or drugs. You must have sufficient physical
- dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload lifts. If in doubt, ask the lift attendant.
