With clear views to Mt Aconcagua, the highest peak in the Americas – and the Pacific Ocean, this is sure to be one of the most unforgettable ski experiences of your life.


- Hotel Termas de Jahuel (2 nights\*): This recently renovated, historic, 4-star landmark resort is nestled in the foothills of the Andes, near San Felipe and is about a 60-minute drive from Ski Arpa. Termas de Jahuel features indoor and outdoor thermal pools, massage and steam baths and is a relaxing oasis after a hard day on the slopes. Visitors to Termas de Jahuel will find cozy, ultra-comfortable guestrooms that are fully stocked with amenities such as mineralized spring-water showers and satellite TV. Trails through the scented forest wind around the resort, which is matched by the elegant resort offerings: dining area, bar, and restaurant. (dinner included)
- Inca Hotel (2 nights\*): The Inca Hotel (not to be confused with the Inca Lodge at Ski Portillo) opened in late 2009 and is conveniently located on the international highway in Los Andes making for easy access to Ski Arpa and Portillo as well as downtown Los Andes. It features two restaurants that serve fresh, internationally-inspired cuisine. The 47 comfortable rooms are tastefully decorated in a rustic, minimalist style. (dinner is not included)

#### Ski Arpa Facts & Statistics:

Ski Arpa is South America's only fully snowcat-serviced ski resort, well-known for deep powder and panoramic views of the Andes Mountains including the highest peak in the Western Hemisphere, Aconcagua.



Season dates: Mid-June through mid-October, exact dates depend on snow conditions

Location: Andes Mountains; 108km (67 miles) north of Santiago, near the town of Los Andes

Terrain: 4,000 acres / 2,000 hectares

Base facilities: Mountain shelter, with a café and restrooms

Elevation: 2,690 meters (8,825 feet) at base; 3,740 meters (12,500 feet) at summit

Vertical descent: 1,050 meters (3,445 feet)

**Number of trails:** Ski Arpa is comprised entirely of backcountry terrain, and skiers choose their own line. Valle El Arpa has four expansive bowls, steep headwalls, chutes, and wide-open runs.

Valle La Honda is a wide-open bowl with approximately 3,000 acres of intermediate to expert terrain. Ski Arpa is entirely above tree line.

Trail classification: Approximately 20% Intermediate, 40% Advanced and 40% Expert.

Snowcats: Ski Arpa has two Pisten Bully snowcats, each with a maximum capacity of 14 people.

Annual snowfall: Averages 5 to 7 meters (15 to 20 feet).

**Prices:** Full day programs include unlimited rides (based on climate conditions and skier ability) of approximately 3000+ vertical feet each with a Ski Arpa mountain guide.
