SALGADOS GOLF COURSE

A course for those who prefer Nature, for Nature lovers, for those who respect her and wish to share unique and magic moments with her.

Salgados Golf Course is located at Herdade dos Salgados, close to Albufeira. Next to Salgados Beach and Salgados Lagoon Nature Reserve, linking the dunes to the sea, Humanity to the Universe.

A shelter for various bird species, some under threat of extinction, this course offers golfers a unique experience with impressive views over the ocean and unique birdsong. We recommend walking over the green, as it is simple, beautiful and almost always flat. This is a very technical course, more cerebral than physical. Due to the wind, its changes, this course is never the same.



Here, almost all the holes are flanked by lagoons and one (number 6) is considered one of the most difficult in the world, as it has a lot of water and is very long.

Holes 7, 8 and 15 are among the loveliest of the course (and region!).

For golf enthusiasts, playing from the yellow tees is a delightful experience.

Par 4: A birdie chance to start your round. Plenty of space to play down the right, but this is semi rough and not always a good lie. Water on the left and right near the green. OB on the right.






Par 5: Difficult par five for most, your second shot is key, maybe hit a shorter second shot or risk a long shot to get nearer the green.






Par 3: Plays a little longer than it looks, especially when the flag is at the back. Water hazard left and right.





Par 4: Stay left off the tee; no bunkers anywhere. OB on the right side of the fairway.

Par 4: Keep your drive down the left, at the back of the green there is water.





Par 5: A tough par five, keep your second shot left close to the trees as the water comes in to the fairway. Most difficult par 5 on the course. OB on the right of the right lake.






Par 4: Very good par four, don't be disappointed with a five. Water hazard on the left and OB on the right.





Par 3: A short hole requiring accuracy and a carefully chosen club for distance. Besides a water hazard running across in front of the green there are two well placed bunkers waiting for errant shots.





Par 4: After the first lake down there is another that you can't see from the tee, but the more you play left the longer your second shot. OB on the 10th faiway on the right.





Par 4: Three deep bunkers left of the fairway, better to avoid off the tee.





Par 4: Try not to hit the ball further than the bunker on the right side as the water comes into play. Bunker in front of the green and water on the back.





Par 3: Depending on the pin position choosing the right club is important, it's important to avoid the bunkers.





Par 4: Hit your favorite club onto the fairway then you are left with a short second shot. The hole has water hazards and a dogleg to the right. Bunkers to the right of the green.





Par 5: Favor left side of the fairway off the tee and for your second shot to avoid the water.






Par 5: You require two good wood shots to give yourself a chance of a good score. This hole requires an accurate second shot to the green as on the left hand side there are a line of three bunkers.





Par 4: After a good drive, you have a chance of a birdie if the flag is at the front of the green, but difficult to get close if the flag is at the back. This green is longer than it looks from the fairway.





Par 3: Play to the heart of the green, especially if the flag is at back of the green.





Par 4: Long par four, you will need a good tee shot to be able to get to the green in two. Water all the way on the right side. OB on the right of the water.
