2021-22 Booking Conditions for Day Heli Packages

I hereby apply to book one of the Selkirk Tangiers Helicopter Skiing LLP (also referred to as STHS) trips as specified in the following terms and conditions which I understand and agree to:

1.1 That I will not be permitted to participate in any STHS trip unless a "Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims, Assumption of Risks and Indemnity Agreement" is properly signed and witnessed onsite by a qualified STHS staff member.

1.2 That STHS requires all participants to be 15 years of age or older. Participants who are 18 years old or younger must have a parent or guardian to co-sign their waiver as well as be with them at all times. See 'STHS Minor Policy' for details.

1.3 It is understood and agreed that it is my responsibility to arrive at the required time and location to commence any trip. It is also my responsibility to ensure proper entry through Canadian Customs and Immigration if entering from outside Canada.

1.4 STHS reserves the right to cancel any ski package at any time. Full refunds will be given in this case.

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- 1.5 STHS reserves the right to cancel a package at any time if STHS prescribed safety procedures are not followed including the wearing of approved masks.
- 1.6 STHS constructs groups based on guest abilities outlined on this form. If abilities are not homogenous, to the point where it adversely affects the heli ski program, STHS reserves the right to move guests into other groups that they may fit better with. STHS also reserves the right to not fly a client for their full package if they aren't fit or able to fulfill the minimum fitness and ability level required for that package. No refund to client or agent will be offered in this case.
- 1.7 STHS constructs groups based on client weights outlined on their individual booking form(s). STHS reserves the right to rearrange groups in order to maintain safe group weights as required by Canadian Aviation regulations.
- 1.8 All medical evacuation costs will be the responsibility of the client.

Down Day Refund Policy While it is the goal of STHS for all our guests to experience the full package they book, some circumstances necessitate cancellation of the heli day. If cancellation occurs, you will be provided with a partial or full refund, based on the following scenarios:

5 Run Adventure & Day Star

- In the very rare occasion STHS decides to cancel the evening before your scheduled day, you will be given a 100% refund.
- If we have space and your schedule permits, we will try to rebook your trip.
- If your heli ski day turns into a "Down Day" you will receive a free ski pass to Revelstoke Mountain Resort, breakfast, and a delicious lunch.
- If Selkirk Tangiers cancels your trip any time before your Backcountry Safety Briefing is complete, we will issue you a 100% refund.
- If we start skiing but do not reach the guaranteed number of runs, STHS will refund \$218+tax for each run not achieved (\$238+tax for the Day star package)
- If you only ski 1 run and rebooking is not an option, we will charge a flat rate of \$480+tax for the adventure package and \$580+tax for the Day star package.

10 Run Expedition

- If one of your heli days is cancelled, we will try our best to reschedule you another day. If you cannot be rescheduled, your package will be changed to a one day 5 Run Adventure program and the price difference will be refunded. In this scenario, the following guidelines will apply to your new package:
 - Backcountry Safety Briefing will be done on the first day even if it's a "Down Day."
 - If you achieve more than 5 runs, extra runs are \$109 + tax per run.
 - Any runs not achieved from the 5 run package will be refunded at the \$218 + tax.
- In the rare circumstance we need to cancel both days, we will issue you a full refund.

Transceivers Use of an STHS issued Barryvox transceiver is mandatory while skiing with us and it is your responsibility to safeguard and return it to us at the conclusion of your stay. Should the transceiver not be returned, a charge of \$550 + tax will be added to your final bill.

HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA,, and their parent companies, subsidiaries, affiliates, respective directors, officers, employees, guides, agents, independent contractors, subcontractors, representatives, successors, assigns, other guests and all heliskiing participants (all of whom are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Releasees").

DEFINITIONS

In this Release Agreement, the term "wilderness activities" shall include all activities, accommodation, transportation, events and services provided, arranged, organized, conducted, sponsored or authorized by the Releasees and shall include but is not limited to: skiing, snowboarding, snowmobiling, hiking, snowshoeing and other form of backcountry travel; rental or use of skis, snowboards or other equipment; demonstrations; orientation and instructional courses; loading, unloading and travel by or movement in or around helicopters, snowcats, snowmobiles and motor vehicles; and other activities, events and services in any way connected with or related to wilderness activities.

AVALANCHE AIRBAG SYSTEM

The Avalanche Airbag System ("AAS") consists of a backpack integrating an airbag system which is inflated by manually pulling an activation handle. Once inflated, an AAS may assist in keeping a person caught in an avalanche closer to the surface, thus potentially increasing the chances of survival. The AAS may not always inflate and may not protect the user against trauma during an avalanche.

ASSUMPTION OF RISKS - AVALANCHES, ALPINE TERRAIN, WILDERNESS TRAVEL, WEATHER ETC. I am aware that wilderness activities involves risks, dangers and hazards. Avalanches occur frequently in the terrain used for wilderness activities and may be caused by natural forces or by persons travelling through the terrain. I acknowledge and accept that the Releasees may fail to predict whether the alpine terrain is safe for wilderness activities or whether an avalanche may occur. The terrain used for wilderness activities is uncontrolled, unmarked, not inspected and involves many risks, dangers and hazards in addition to that of avalanche. These may include, but are not limited to: cornices; crevasses; cliffs; trees, tree wells and tree stumps; creeks; rocks; boulders; forest deadfall; holes and depressions on or below the snow surface; variable and difficult snow conditions; snowcat roads and road banks, fences, and other man-made structures; snow immersion; impact or collision with other persons, vehicles or objects; encounters with domestic or wild animals; loss of balance or control; slips, trips and falls; becoming lost or separated from one's party or guide; infectious disease contracted through viruses, bacteria, parasites, and fungi which may be transmitted through direct or indirect contact; equipment failure; negligent first aid; negligence of other persons, including other guests; and NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES. I UNDERSTAND THAT NEGLIGENCE INCLUDES FAILURE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES TO TAKE REASONABLE STEPS TO SAFEGUARD OR PROTECT ME FROM OR WARN ME OF THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS OF WILDERNESS ACTIVITIES. Communication in the alpine terrain is difficult and in the event of an accident, rescue and medical treatment may not be available. Alpine weather conditions may be extreme and can change rapidly and without warning, making travel by helicopter, snowcat or snowmobile hazardous.

I AM AWARE OF THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS ASSOCIATED WITH WILDERNESS ACTIVITIES AND I FREELY ACCEPT AND FULLY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS AND THE POSSIBILITY OF PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR LOSS RESULTING THEREFROM.

NOTICE TO SNOWBOARDERS AND TELEMAR SKIERS - INCREASED RISK

Unlike alpine ski boot/binding systems, snowboard and some telemark boot/binding systems are not designed or intended to release and will not release under normal circumstances. The use of a safety strap or retention device by snowboarders or telemark skiers without ski brakes will increase the risk of not surviving an avalanche.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of THE RELEASEES allowing me to participate in wilderness activities, I hereby agree as follows:

1. TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that I have or may in the future have against THE RELEASEES and TO RELEASE THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any loss, damage, expense or injury including death that I may suffer or that my next of kin may suffer as a result of my participation in wilderness activities, DUE TO ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, BREACH OF CONTRACT, OR BREACH OF ANY STATUTORY OR OTHER DUTY OF CARE, INCLUDING ANY DUTY OF CARE OWED UNDER THE OCCUPIERS LIABILITY ACT, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 337, ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES. I UNDERSTAND THAT NEGLIGENCE INCLUDES FAILURE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES TO TAKE REASONABLE STEPS TO SAFEGUARD OR PROTECT ME FROM OR WARN ME OF THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS OF PARTICIPATING IN WILDERNESS ACTIVITIES;
2. TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any property damage or personal injury to any third party resulting from my participation in wilderness activities;
3. This Release Agreement shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns and representatives, in the event of my death or incapacity;
4. This Release Agreement and any rights, duties and obligations as between the parties to this Release Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of British Columbia and no other jurisdiction; and
5. Any litigation involving the parties to this Release Agreement shall be brought solely within British Columbia and shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of British Columbia.

In entering into this Release Agreement I am not relying on any oral or written representations or statements made by the Releasees with respect to the safety of wilderness activities, other than what is set forth in this Release Agreement.

I CONFIRM THAT I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS RELEASE AGREEMENT AND I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS RELEASE AGREEMENT I AM WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS WHICH I OR MY HEIRS, NEXT OF KIN, EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS, ASSIGNS AND REPRESENTATIVES MAY HAVE AGAINST THE RELEASEES. I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THIS RELEASE AGREEMENT SHALL APPLY TO ALL FUTURE PARTICIPATION IN WILDERNESS ACTIVITIES.
