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WHAT TO EXPECT AT CHECK-IN

We like all our guests to arrive at 8:00 am in the morning of their ski day. If you are on resort prior, you are more than welcome to come in and see us the day before to get your paperwork done. Our standard industry Wilderness Activity Waiver and ski rental form will need to be filled out and completed. We've included a copy of these forms for you to have a read over and familiarize yourself to save you time at check in.

Please make sure to bring your ski or snowboard boots with you.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS ON YOUR SKI DAY

(Please remember we are Mountain Standard Time, MST)

8:00 - 8:30 am

Arrive and check in with our front desk staff. Your Wilderness Activity Waiver and ski/snowboard rental form will need to be filled out and signed.

8:00 am

Start breakfast at Chopper's Landing Restaurant.

8:30 am

Guide introductory talk. This initiates the first of three morning safety talks required prior to your adventure. While you finish up your breakfast your guide will discuss and demonstrate various safety equipment and give a detailed explanation of how the day unfolds.

9:30 am onwards

Last minute washroom break in the Heliplex. Fly out to the first run of the day or drive 12 km to the helipad staging area by shuttle, to be picked up by the helicopter.

Ski your heart out with a picnic style lunch in the mountains. Your guide will ask about interest in extra runs which are \$120.00 per run + GST (5%).

as winter mountain roads can be slow moving.



PAYMENT, CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICIES

Heliski package deposits/payments are non-refundable in whole or in part. If you choose to stop skiing prior to completing your package on any given day no refund will be issued for the unskied runs. All skiers are expected to be in suitable physical condition to complete your purchased number of runs in your package. In the event that you have not purchased trip cancellation insurance and you are unable to ski on your confirmed ski date, RK. Heliski will not be held responsible for refunding any portion of your payments received. Payments received are non-transferable to other RK. Heliski programs.

Payments in full are due at the time of booking for all 3 and 5 run daily packages and Semi Private packages. Private Platinum bookings require a 50% deposit at time of booking with remaining balance due 10 weeks prior to your first ski date.

We recommend you purchase trip cancellation insurance. This may be purchased through Acera Travel. You can contact Acera Travel at travel@acera.ca or 1-877-542-8577, https:// lifestylefinancial.ca/get-a-quote/rk-heliskiing or through your own travel agent. Please be sure that you are covered and are familiar with our cancellation policy. In the event that you have not purchased trip cancellation insurance and you are unable to ski on your confirmed ski date, RK. Heliski will not be held responsible for refunding any portion of your payments received. Payments received are non-transferable to any other RK. Heliski program. Trip cancellation insurance will not cover you changing your mind to ski on your designated day once payment has been received.

IMPORTANT! If inclement weather, mechanical reasons or avalanche conditions prevents the helicopter from flying on your designated day, any transportation costs from Banff or Lake Louise will not be refunded.

NO FLY DAYS, DETERMINED BY MECHANICAL OR WEATHER REASONS

If inclement weather, mechanical reasons or avalanche conditions prevents the helicopter from flying on your designated day, you will be provided with a partial or full refund based on the following conditions:

- If RK. Heliski cancels on a day of your trip, we will try and rebook you if possible. If RK.
 Heliski is unable to rebook you, guests can either opt for a full refund or apply payment
 towards an excursion for a later date. Refunds will be issued in the same manner as the
 original payment. Direct funds will be issued to travel agents for agency bookings.
- 2. If RK. Heliski cancels the day after breakfast and our mandatory safety training, a \$65.00 +GST administration fee will apply. Clients can either request RK. Heliski refund the balance or apply the remaining balance towards an excursion for a later date.
- In the event that RK. Heliski has proceeded with your day but the guaranteed number of runs could not be achieved. RK. Heliski will refund you \$250.00 + GST (5%), for each run not completed.

EMERGENCY MEDI-EVACUATION PLAN

All of RK. Heliski's packages include helicopter flight time coverage for medical evacuation from the backcountry to the staging area, Heliplex or Invermere District Hospital. **The Evacuation Program does not cover any provincial ground, air ambulance transfer costs or medical costs should they be required.**

MINORS GOING SKIING OR SNOWBOARDING

As our company policy, the minimum age to heliski is 14 years of age. In all cases the guardian must ski with the minor on every run. The guide can cancel the minors skiing at any time, if in their judgment could jeopardize the safety or enjoyment of the other guests. They must also understand that if the guardian stops skiing for any reason the minor will have too also. A waiver will be signed by the guardian separately. A second waiver will also be signed by both the minor and the guardian.

WAIVER FORMS

There are inherent risks in heliskiing. During the check in process, all guests skiing or snowboarding are required to read and then sign a waiver of liability which releases RK. Heliski Panorama Inc. from liability and acceptance of risks.

SAFETY & GUIDING

The safety of our guests is our top priority. Our guides have the best training in North American and are certified by the Association of Canadian Mountain Guides (ACMG), on the International Federation of Mountain Guides (IFMGA). They also have all the necessary training to be professionals in their field of expertise.

WEATHER & TERRAIN

On any given day, weather and avalanche hazard is the determining factor to where we ski. RK. Heliski's guides and pilots work hand in hand to provide the best possible terrain and snow conditions possible.

DEFINITIONS

In this Release Agreement, the term "wilderness activities" shall include all activities, accommodation, transportation, events and services provided, arranged, organized, conducted, sponsored or authorized by the Releasees and shall include but is not limited to: skiing, snowboarding, snowmobiling, hiking, snowshoeing and other form of backcountry travel; rental or use of skis, snowboards or other equipment; demonstrations; orientation and instructional courses; loading, unloading and travel by or movement in or around helicopters, snowcats, snowmobiles and motor vehicles; and other activities, events and services in any way connected with or related to wilderness activities.

AVALANCHE AIRBAG SYSTEM

The Avalanche Airbag System ("AAS") consists of a backpack integrating an airbag system which is inflated by manually pulling an activation handle. Once inflated, an AAS may assist in keeping a person caught in an avalanche closer to the surface, thus potentially increasing the chances of survival. The AAS may not always inflate and may not protect the user against trauma during an avalanche.

ASSUMPTION OF RISKS - AVALANCHES, ALPINE TERRAIN, WILDERNESS TRAVEL, WEATHER ETC. I am aware that wilderness activities involves risks, dangers and hazards. Avalanches occur frequently in the terrain used for wilderness activities and may be caused by natural forces or by persons travelling through the terrain. I acknowledge and accept that the Releasees may fail to predict whether the alpine terrain is safe for wilderness activities or whether an avalanche may occur. The terrain used for wilderness activities is uncontrolled, unmarked, not inspected and involves many risks, dangers and hazards in addition to that of avalanche. These may include, but are not limited to: cornices; crevasses; cliffs; trees, tree wells and tree stumps; creeks; rocks; boulders; forest deadfall; holes and depressions on or below the snow surface; cliffs; variable and difficult snow conditions; snowcat roads and road banks, fences, and other man-made structures; snow immersion; impact or collision with other persons, vehicles or objects; encounters with domestic or wild animals; loss of balance or control; slips, trips and falls; becoming lost or separated from one's party or guide; infectious disease contracted through viruses, bacteria, parasites, and fungi which may be transmitted through direct or indirect contact; equipment failure; negligent first aid; negligence of other persons, including other guests; and NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES. I UNDERSTAND THAT NEGLIGENCE INCLUDES FAILURE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES TO TAKE REASONABLE STEPS TO SAFEGUARD OR PROTECT ME FROM OR WARN ME OF THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS OF WILDERNESS ACTIVITIES. Communication in the alpine terrain is difficult and in the event of an accident, rescue and medical treatment may not be available. Alpine weather conditions may be extreme and can change rapidly and without warning, making travel by helicopter, snowcat or snowmobile hazardous.

I AM AWARE OF THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS ASSOCIATED WITH WILDERNESS ACTIVITIES AND I FREELY ACCEPT AND FULLY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS AND THE POSSIBILITY OF PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR LOSS RESULTING THEREFROM.

NOTICE TO SNOWBOARDERS AND TELEMARK SKIERS - INCREASED RISK

Unlike alpine ski boot/binding systems, snowboard and some telemark boot/binding systems are not designed or intended to release and will not release under normal circumstances. The use of a safety strap or retention device by snowboarders or telemark skiers without ski brakes will increase the risk of not surviving an avalanche.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of THE RELEASEES allowing me to participate in wilderness activities, I hereby agree as follows:

- 1. TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that I have or may in the future have against THE RELEASEES and TO RELEASE THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any loss, damage, expense or injury including death that I may suffer or that my next of kin may suffer as a result of my participation in wilderness activities, DUE TO ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, BREACH OF CONTRACT, OR BREACH OF ANY STATUTORY OR OTHER DUTY OF CARE, INCLUDING ANY DUTY OF CARE OWED UNDER THE OCCUPIERS LIABILITY ACT, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 337, ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES. I UNDERSTAND THAT NEGLIGENCE INCLUDES FAILURE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES TO TAKE REASONABLE STEPS TO SAFEGUARD OR PROTECT ME FROM OR WARN ME OF THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS OF PARTICIPATING IN WILDERNESS ACTIVITIES;
- 2. TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any property damage or personal injury to any third party resulting from my participation in wilderness activities;
- 3. This Release Agreement shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns and representatives, in the event of my death or incapacity;
- 4. This Release Agreement and any rights, duties and obligations as between the parties to this Release Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of British Columbia and no other jurisdiction; and
- 5. Any litigation involving the parties to this Release Agreement shall be brought solely within British Columbia and shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of British Columbia.

In entering into this Release Agreement I am not relying on any oral or written representations or statements made by the Releasees with respect to the safety of wilderness activities, other than what is set forth in this Release Agreement.

I CONFIRM THAT I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS RELEASE AGREEMENT AND I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS RELEASE AGREEMENT I AM WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS WHICH I OR MY HEIRS, NEXT OF KIN, EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS, ASSIGNS AND REPRESENTATIVES MAY HAVE AGAINST THE RELEASEES. I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THIS RELEASE AGREEMENT SHALL APPLY TO ALL FUTURE PARTICIPATION IN WILDERNESS ACTIVITIES.

- 3. [SKIERS ONLY] I have made no misrepresentation in regard to my height, weight, age or skier type. (This information is required in order to properly adjust the ski boot/binding settings). I agree to verify that the settings appearing in the visual indicator windows on the bindings correspond with the settings to be recorded on this form.

ASSUMPTION OF RISKS

I am aware that alpine skiing, telemark skiing and snowboarding involve risks, dangers and hazards and that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence in these sports.

ALPINE SKIING I understand that the ski boot/binding system may not release during every fall or may release unexpectedly. The ski boot/binding system is no guarantee that the user will not be injured .

SNOWBOARDING/TELEMARK SKIING I understand that the snowboard boot /binding system and some telemark boot/binding system are not designed or intended to release and will not release under normal circumstances. I understand that as the boot/binding system is a non release - system, this system will not reduce the risk of in jury during a fall and will increase the risk of not surviving an avalanche. The use of safety strap or retention device by snowboarders or telemark skiers without ski brakes will also increase the risk of not surviving an avalanche.

I FREELY ACCEPT AND FULLY ASSUME ALL RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS ASSOCIATED WITH THE USE OF THE EQUIPMENT.

- 2. TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any damage to property of or personal injury to any third party, resulting from my use of the Equipment;
- 3. This Release Agreement shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns and representatives, in the event of my death or incapacity;
- 4. This Release Agreement and any rights, duties and obligations as between the parties to this Release Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of the Province of British Columbia and no other jurisdiction; and
- 5. Any litigation involving the parties to this Release Agreement shall be brought solely within the Province of British Columbia and shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of the Province of British Columbia.

I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS RELEASE AGREEMENT AND I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS RELEASE AGREEMENT I AM WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS WHICH I OR MY HEIRS, NEXT OF KIN, EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS, ASSIGNS AND REPRESENTATIVES MAY HAVE AGAINST THE RELEASEES.
